



CATEGORICAL EXCLUSION REVIEW


Proposed Action. The proposed action is issuing an "O&C Logging Road Right-of-Way Permit" to V. Leroy Pruitt for a term of 5 years pursuant to the authority of Title V of the Federal Land Policy and Management Act of 1976 (43 U.S.C. 1761), subject to the terms and conditions in 43 CFR 2812 and those additional stipulations in the attached Exhibit A. The permit would authorize the hauling of approximately 30 MBF of timber over 0.20 miles of BLM-controlled road 16-2E-33.1, and across the public lands and BLM easements specified on page one of the permit. No new construction is involved. Road maintenance of road 16-2E-33.1, will be performed by BLM.

Decision: It is my decision to approve the issuance of an "O&C Logging Road Right-of-Way Permit" to V. Leroy Pruitt for a term of 5 years pursuant to the authority of Title V of the Federal Land Policy and management Act of 1976 (43 U.S.C. 1761), subject to the terms and conditions in 43 CFR 2812 and those additional stipulations in the attached Exhibit A. The permit shall authorize the use of road 16-2E-33.1, across the public lands and interests in land described in the permit.


Rationale: The proposed action qualifies as a categorical exclusion as described in the Departmental Manual 516 DM 6, Appendix 5.4E(16), and does not meet any of the exception criteria. The proposed action is in conformance with the *Record of Decision for Amendments to Forest Service and Bureau of Land Management Planning Documents within the Range of the Northern Spotted Owl, April 1994 (ROD)*, and the *Eugene District Record of Decision and Resource Management Plan, June 1995 (Eugene District ROD/RMP)* as amended by the *Record of Decision for Amendments to the Survey and Manage, Protection Buffer, and other Mitigation Measures Standards and Guidelines, USDA Forest Service and USDI Bureau of Land Management January 2001.*
